MEMBER SEVERELY REPRIMANDED

On 17 November 2003, the Disciplinary Committee found proved a complaint, that Mr John J Lundy, FCCA, sole practitioner of John Lundy & Co, of Sussex Road, Dublin 4, Ireland, was liable to disciplinary action under bye-law 8(a)(i) and (ii) in that, contrary to Fundamental Principle 2, he provided misleading information.

The Committee ordered that Mr Lundy should be excluded from membership, pay costs of €2,090, and that the decision should be published in the professional and local press referring to him by name.

Mr Lundy appealed against the orders that he should be excluded from membership and that the decision should be published in the professional and local press referring to him by name. On 16 March 2004, the Appeal Committee varied the order that Mr Lundy should be excluded from membership, to orders that he should be severely reprimanded and pay a fine of €10,000. It affirmed the order that the decision should be published in the professional and local press referring to him by name. The Committee made no order as to costs of the appeal hearing.
